

## **Level 2 Guidelines for Hockey 2021**

The draw will run on a Thursday and a Friday after school at the College.

I already have your contact tracing sheets for each of the teams. If you have any changes to this, then please let me know.

If the change of night does not suit your team or you do not wish to carry on then you may pull out of the competition and receive a refund. The plan is that competition will run until the end of this term and then next term for three weeks.

### **On arrival:**

- \* All people 12 and over must wear a mask. This includes the coach and manager. The coach may remove their mask to coach. Spectators, please try and social distance from people you don't know.
- \* There are QR codes cable tied to the fence. Please make sure that all adults scan in.
- \* If you do not have an appropriate phone, then sign in on the paper on the desk where there is also hand sanitiser.
- \* There is an on duty person who will be at the entry point. Please meet there and follow the instructions provided. Please look at the diagram and follow the entry and exit points. Please make sure you don't mix with the next round. There is a designated area to watch the game, and then to leave via the designated exit.
- \* There will be two toilets open, which are on the far side of the gym.
- \* Please listen, respect and follow instructions as asked from the organiser on the night.
- \* If you feel unwell or display any covid symptoms then please do not attend.
- \* Thanks. It is important that we follow the guidelines if we want to continue to run this competition under level 2 restrictions.
