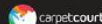

A post will be put on our learning portal (HERO) that parents will be able to access that summarises where their child is achieving in reading, writing and maths and any other important points noted in the conversation by the end of Week 7.*

##### Calves:

Early 1st July - 20th July  
Late 21st July - 1st Sept.

##### Lambs & Goats:

Early 1st July - 31st July  
Late 1st August - 1st Sept.

##### Male Animals:

Individual schools have their own ruling with regards to male animals entering their Livestock Days.

Over the past two years the committee has allowed entries from schools for students with rams or bucks and will be the same for 2020, along with the continued bull section.

To clarify....

- Ram Lambs can be entered and are not required to be castrated or rung
- Buck goats or crypt orchids can be entered and are not required to be castrated or rung
- Bull calf section will be available


