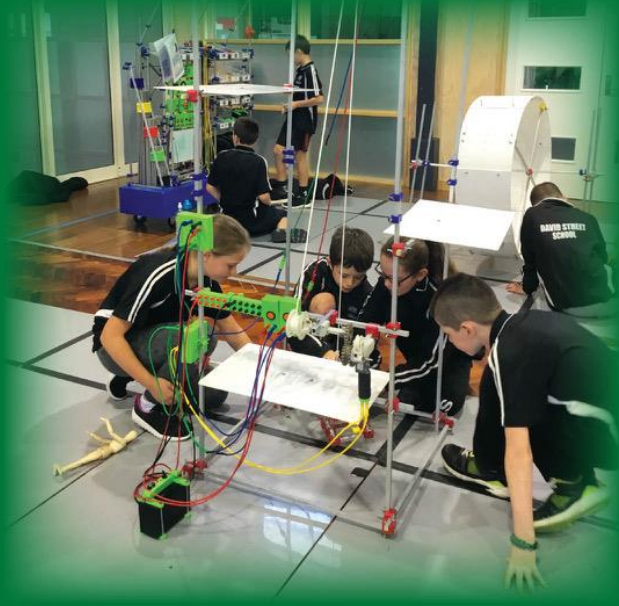
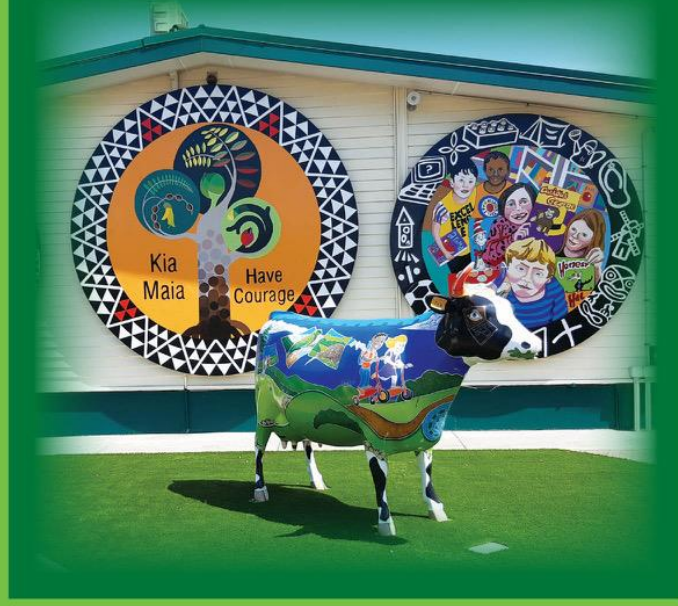

### Part time 2IC

### Morning/After school/Holiday Programme

David Street School is looking to appoint a new 2IC to join their team for their morning and after school and holiday programme 'Care for Kids'. The 2IC will be a part of the team who assists the current Manager to ensure a quality programme is provided for our families.

Due to Ministry requirements the applicant needs to be over 20 years of age, would ideally have experience in working with children, be able to take charge and manage large groups of children as well as co-ordinate and organise support staff.

A police check and safety check will be required. A current first aid certificate is an advantage. There is some flexibility with 2IC's hours, and this can be discussed with the Manager of the programme.

Likely between 8 - 20 hours per week during term time and more hours available throughout the school holiday period.
