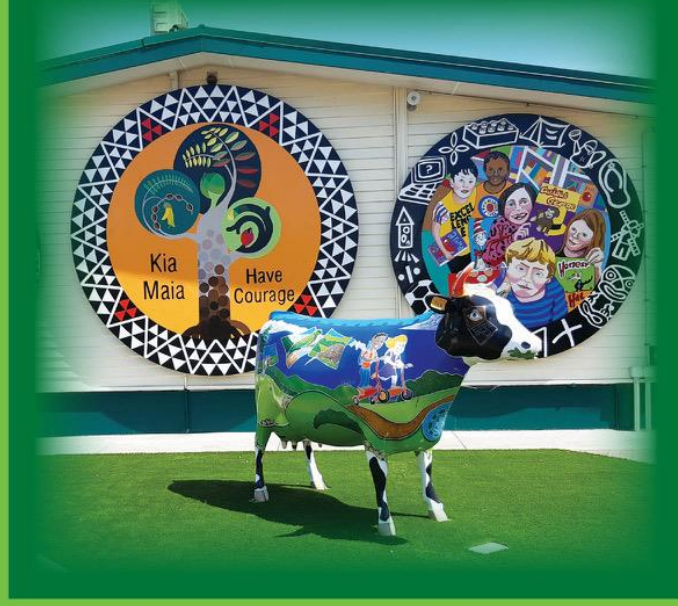

After the consultation with the venue, the organisers of the event have made the decision to operate at Alert Level 2, under the advice and guidelines set out by the New Zealand Government and the Ministry of Health. The event will be run slightly differently to how it has in the past.

This will mean that the competitors will start in groups of a maximum of 100 – all groups will start 15 minutes apart. Each group of entrants will be allocated a specific shower/toilet/changing area so that the groups do not mix.

Due to the uncertainty about whether we will be out of Level 2 or not next week, the Piako Gymnastics festival has decided to run the event under Level 2 with these guidelines. The Gymnastics events will run on Friday the 11th of September, however Trampoline and the Group Performances (hip hop, aerobics & cheerleading) will not. Unfortunately, this will also mean there are to be no spectators on the day.

The Trampoline & Group Performances will attend the Hamilton Festival on the 24th, dependent on the levels then.

Part time 2IC

Morning/After school/Holiday Programme

David Street School is looking to appoint a new 2IC to join their team for their morning and after school and holiday programme 'Care for Kids'. The 2IC will be a part of the team who assists the current Manager to ensure a quality programme is provided for our families.

Due to Ministry requirements the applicant needs to be over 20 years of age, would ideally have experience in working with children, be able to take charge and manage large groups of children as well as co-ordinate and organise support staff.

There is some flexibility with 2IC's hours, and this can be discussed with the Manager of the programme.
