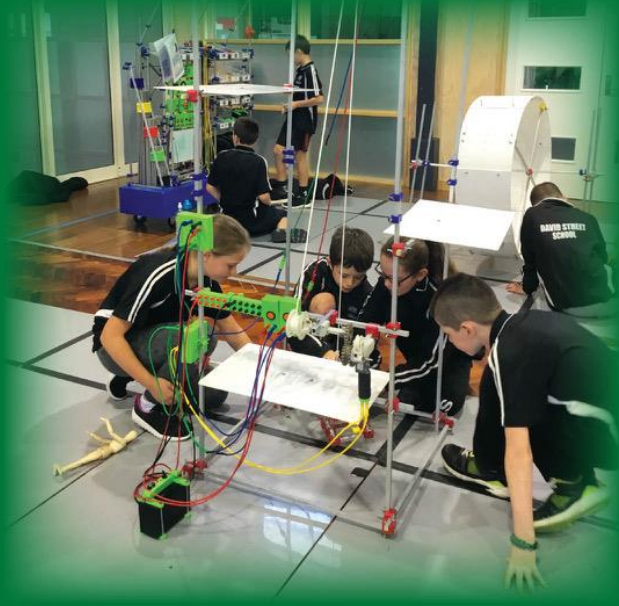
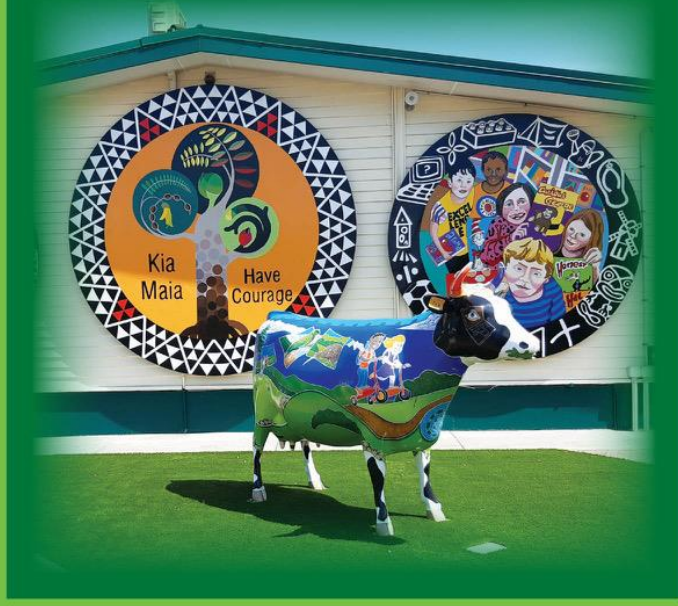

Star Warts – The Umpire Strikes Back

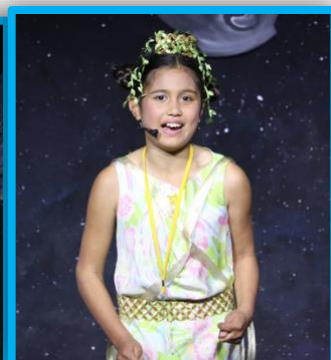

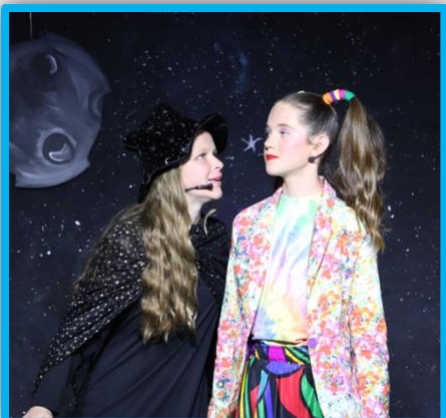
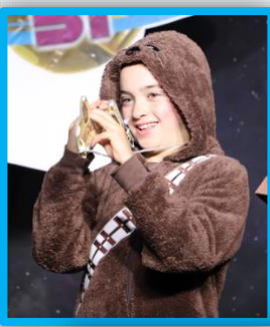
There cannot be a show without the support of our many helpers and supportive audience, we had such amazing feedback from all of our 3 shows. Thank you.
