Organisational Update

Teacher Only Day Advance Notice. Friday 6 November

The school will be **closed** on this day however, the Care for Kids programme will be running for those who require it (limited numbers). The cost of care is \$35 for the day. Open from 7.15am to 5.30pm. Bookings are required. Please contact Pia if you are requiring care on Teacher Only Day. Ph 0273 691 263. Note: We have aligned our date with that of Morrinsville Intermediate School's Teachers Only Day.

We are currently at Covid-19 Alert Level 1

Our extended community are continuing to take COVID-19 seriously through using the COVID tracer App, staying away if they are sick, seeking medical advice and getting tested if recommended to do so. Thank you all, for your efforts.

- **There are no restrictions on personal movement at Alert Level 1 – all children and staff should be at school.** – The only people who will need to stay away are: Those required to self-isolate - Individuals who health authorities have asked to stay away while waiting for a test result - Children, students and staff who are unwell.
- **Student Illness** - If students are sick, they should remain at home. Parents should contact Healthline or their GP to ensure they are safe to return to school. *If students come to school unwell parents will be asked to come and pick them up.*
- **Personal Hygiene** - We continue to focus on washing and drying hands, coughing into elbows and not touching our faces. Soap, water and paper towels will still be available in all classrooms.
- **End of Day - our normal end of day @ 3pm continues for all students.**
- **Contact Tracing** - At Level 1 there are no restrictions on gatherings. Parents are welcome on site. If students arrive at school late or leave school early, they need to be signed in or out at the school office as normal. All visitors need to be signed in also. (This does not include parents who are picking up or dropping off children.) A QR code will remain on display for those who wish to keep a record of where they have been on their personal tracker.
