#### **David Street Roundabout Troubles.**

We have had two minor crash incidents in the Roundabout over the last 2 weeks.

There was also a 'near miss' when a child got out of the car on the outside traffic side of the roundabout.

The school roundabout **drop off** zones are just that. The accidents have occurred when a car is parked in the zone and others have had to reverse to exit.

#### We now insist that:

- Drivers must remain with their vehicle and drive off as soon as their child is safely on the footpath.
- Children must exit the vehicle on the footpath side of the roundabout.

The evening is being held at Morrinsville College next week, Wednesday 31st March. 7pm - 8.30pm


This will be an invaluable tool for any parent/caregiver with children.
