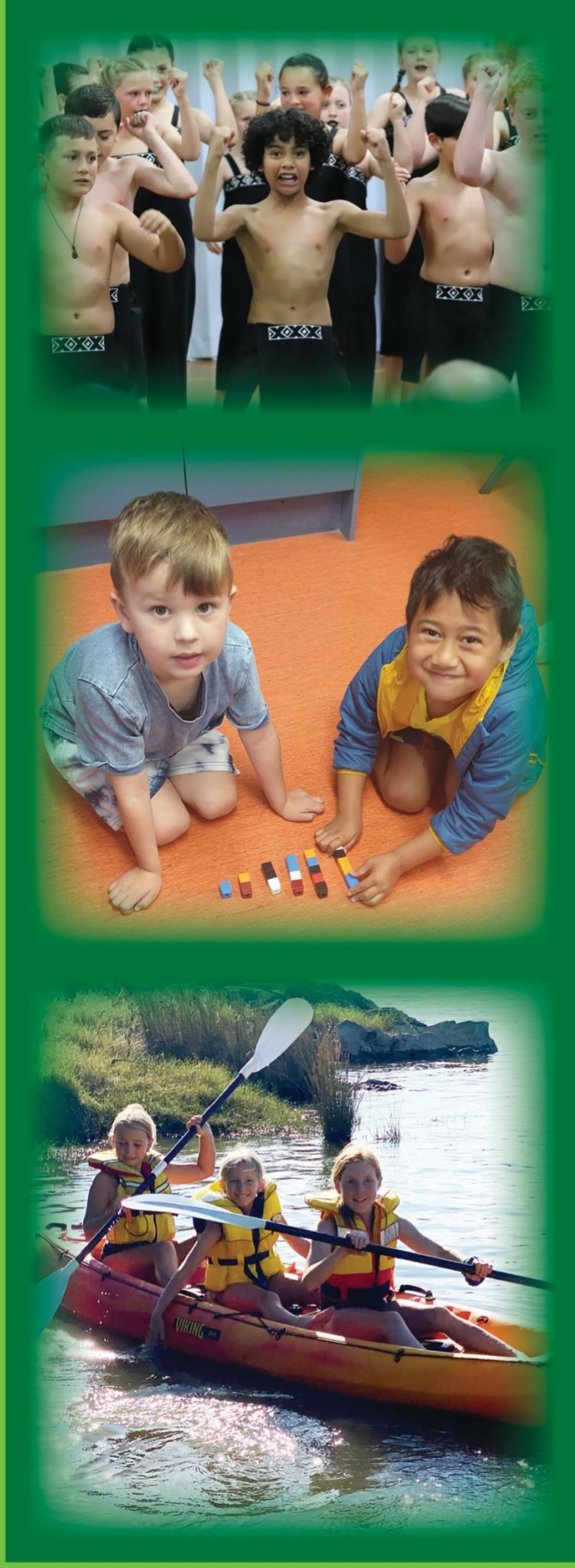

Basketball Fun Day Canteen – Helpers & Baking Required

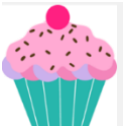
Our Home & School committee will be running a canteen on the day to help raise money for the school.

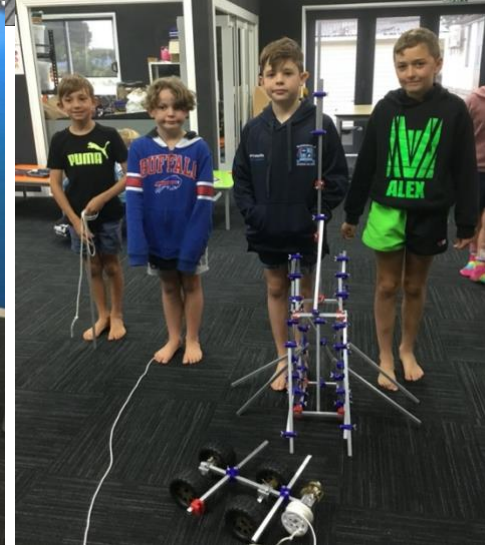
