Thank you to our families who attended our Maths information Event on Tuesday evening. There was a very relaxed and supportive 'vibe' from all who came.

We heard from Bruce Moody, one of the country's leading mathematics educators and school professional learning facilitators. He spoke about the current New Zealand curriculum approaches to learning and teaching mathematics. Bruce has been working with David Street children and staff over the last eighteen months with noticeable rises in student confidence, engagement and achievement at every level of the school.

Another rewarding feature of the night for teachers were the positive conversations and engagement with parents in the learning activities each team had set up for parents to try across all year levels of the school. Parents did almost as well as our children do each day...so well done everyone. We also appreciated all the very positive feedback received from our parents. Thank you.

#### Canteen Helpers – we still require helpers

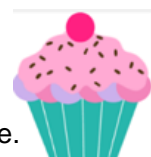
