

School Attendance

The Education Act imposes clear expectations on schools and parents to ensure that all children attend school regularly during the days and times a school is open (8.55 am until 3.00 pm).

A major concern recently, has been the dramatic increase in lateness to school.

Children arriving in class late are often upset when they find their friends are already engaged in learning. The teacher then must disengage from the group they are teaching to set that child up with their current activities. Late children also miss the pre class routines and the opportunity to share their stories with friends and teacher as they arrive. Being set up well for a full day of learning does make a difference to the effectiveness of a child's learning and sense of wellbeing.

Many parents are also not aware that removing a child from school, even during lunchtimes, is also not 'justified' under the act unless it is for a medical or similar professional appointment. The principal does have limited discretion to approve removal from school where there are unusual circumstances however. Other than in emergencies, parents must discuss this with the principal beforehand.

A reminder that the school roundabout drop off zones are just that. School gates are busy places especially before and after school.

The rules at the roundabout are designed in consultation with police, to ensure the safety of our children.

Let's work together to ensure the safety of every child.

We now insist that:

Drivers must remain with their vehicle and drive off as soon as their child is safely on the footpath. Children must exit the vehicle on the footpath side of the roundabout.
