

### New Administration Block Board of Trustees Update.

Plans for our new administration block go out to tender next week.

Because of the way the Ministry of Education funding works, the project will be completed in 2 stages. If all goes well, work on stage 1 (offices, sickbay and meeting rooms) will begin in October. There is insufficient room where our current admin is, so our new block will be positioned on the grassed area between the hall and the main gate roundabout.

Our old block was built over sixty years ago when the school had 6 classrooms. There are now 21 classrooms and six times the staff. Our current facility has been hopelessly inadequate for over 20 years and we are excited at the prospect of finally achieving a fit for purpose facility.
