





### Please book early as there are limited spaces available.

Please be aware once your child's enrolment is confirmed you will be charged if they are absent unless we have received a minimum of a weeks' notice of the change.

### **Keeping Everyone Safe at Delta Level 2**

Under Level 2 we ask parents not to come onto the school site unless it is essential to do so. Essential visitors to school must wear a face mask.

- All students who are well, should come to school.
- Any child or staff member who is unwell must not be at school. Anyone becoming sick at school must be collected.
- Please let the school office know before 8.30am if you child is not coming to school. We need to know so we can ensure everyone who is meant to be at school has arrived safely.
- Remind your child that there is no sharing of food or drink
- Drinking fountains are open and cleaned throughout the day, however we recommend each child brings their own water bottle.
- After School Care/ Care For Kids is open under alert Level 2.

### **Dropping Children to School at Level 2**

- Children can enter at any of our three gates as they have been doing, a staff member will be there to welcome them.
- Parents should not come onto the school site. While we require parents to drop children off at any of our gates, we understand it may be necessary to accompany especially new children to and from the classroom. If it is essential for you to come onto the schoolgrounds to drop or pick up your child, please enter at the David Street roundabout gate ONLY. The required Contact Tracing Record will be collected only at this gate. You must wear a mask and must not enter classrooms.

### **School Office**

- If it is essential for you to come to the school office, please keep visits to a minimum. There is limited space in the office and there is a 1 in and 1 out policy.
- You will need to sign in either via our barcode on the door or Contact Tracing Register inside the office.
- Face masks are required to be worn.

### **Contacting School**

We are always available, the easiest way to get in touch with your child's teacher is via their school email address, these can be found on our school website. You can also phone the school office for general information. 889-7780

### **After School**

- Please discuss with your child/ren about the designated place to meet near one of the gates for after school.
- As with our usual rules around pick-up, Children Are Unable To Be Picked Up By Parents In Cars From The Roundabout. This ensures the safety of children and avoids congestion at peak times.
