



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

### **MOE Guidelines - Covid**

There has been a significant change to the MOE guidelines we are operating under this week, and we are expecting more before the weekend.

From now on... students and staff wearing masks will not automatically be deemed a CLOSE CONTACT if or when there is a confirmed Covid case in your child's class. Children who wear masks will now become CASUAL CONTACTS, and may still come to school.

It is possible, that in the case of a confirmed classroom case, all without masks will become Close Contacts and will be required to isolate at home. Fortunately, for now, we still have no confirmed cases of Covid.

# Road Safety



With the start of another school year and many students travelling to and from school it is timely to remind our school community to take care on the roads and footpaths around the school. The safety of our students is an ongoing concern for us.

On Monday one of our children was seen crossing the road into traffic. Our road patrol children and staff were on duty at the time but the student thought it better not to use the crossing. It was a heart stopping moment for all who saw it.

We constantly remind our students to abide by sensible road safe rules and have staff present at the beginning and end of the school day. We have two zebra crossings that are patrolled every school day by trained students and staff from:

8.10am – 8.45am and 3.00pm – 3.15pm every school day.

Please talk to your children about road safety and using the school crossing. Using the pedestrian crossings with your children while out also teaches them safe road crossing procedures.
