



It has been wonderful to see how active our children have become as they have embraced the range of sporting activities provided in school and also the community. We are noticing that the increased levels of fitness amongst our students is paying off in terms of higher levels of sustained engagement in learning activities in classrooms. We believe this will further support our continuous drive to increase achievement levels across the school.

You are likely to be aware of the government and schools growing concern about the **falling levels of attendance** of students nationwide

The Ministry of education have reminded schools of their **legal responsibility** to take all reasonable steps **to ensure that students attend the school when it is open.** 


Many parents seem unaware that there is also a requirement for parents to seek permission from the principal to collect children during the school day for reasons other than medical appointments and the like.

While David Street School's attendance patterns are amongst the highest in the country, and parents do appreciate the accommodating stance we take when necessary, we have a growing frustration at the disruption caused to classroom programmes when children regularly arrive late to school, or are collected early in the afternoon.

You will know that bus children leave the classroom at 2.45pm each day to catch the school bus, and a number of other children have arrangements with the school to be collected once a week **at this time** to meet sporting or cultural events in other towns. Our learning programmes do accommodate this when required.

Please make an arrangement with the principal prior to signing them out if you require an early pick up from school for reasons other than important appointments.

### **Netball**




