



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

Matariki Buddy Art with Room 7 and Room 19

Last week, the seniors spent some time with Room 7 and Room 19. Working with them as tuakana-teina. They helped us to create some art based around Matariki.

Room 7 - We weaved coloured paper strips onto a Matariki inspired word art background. We had to carefully choose a colour to weave through that would complement our background (to do this we learnt that we need to select a colour from the opposite side of the colour wheel). Then we chose a template of a traditional Māori design, traced around it on black paper, cut out the shape in the middle and glued it onto our weaving.






2. ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT

Follow the Link on the email to activate your account.


Enter a password that you will remember into the blocks supplied.

Check your order is correct and Click on Check out and complete payment instructions.


Use the Drop down box to choose Credit Card or Bank Transfer


3. CLICK ON THE SHOP YOU WANT TO USE
