## Update to Covid-19 Settings

You'll be aware that New Zealand has now moved away from the covid-19 Protection Framework (traffic lights). This will only result in a minor changes for our school.

# Household contacts of a person with COVID-19 no longer need to isolate, but instead are asked to complete a RAT test daily for five days.

What this means for us:

- Students who are household contacts (but test negative AND do not have COVID-19 symptoms), are still able to attend school each day. (RAT tests are required to be done at home daily for 5 days to ensure they remain covid free while at school).
- There is no change for **Positive cases**. They are still required to isolate for the full 7 days.

## Mask wearing is no longer required at school or on public/school transport.

What this means for us:

- o Students are not required to wear masks on school buses or while at school.
- Parents/visitors to the school are not required to wear masks while visiting our school.

**All the other recommended public health measures** will stay in place as we know they reduce the spread of infectious illnesses including COVID-19.

These include:

- o Ensuring our indoor spaces are well-ventilated (opening windows and doors)
- Maintaining good hand hygiene
- $\circ$   $\quad$  Encouraging everyone to cough or sneeze into elbows
- Most importantly, staying home if unwell and getting tested if they have COVID-19 symptoms.

We look forward to seeing more of our children at school and thank you for your continued support in protecting our tamariki and wider school community.
