We had an amazing day yesterday at the soccer/hockey fun day.




The DSS students showed great sportsmanship and were amazing role models for our school. I was impressed with their honesty and determination during the games. Everyone gave it their best effort!

DOWNLOD HERO FROM:

The App Store & Google Play

The Hero Mobile App is our main way to communicate your child's progress, your child's school report information and school financial statements to parents & caregivers

Hero can be downloaded as an app for your device to make it even more convenient.

- · Parent accounts are managed by the school, all we need is your email address on our system. Please let us know if your email address changes.
- Your child's learning stories; assessments; progress data; school financial account, can all be accessed through Hero.
- Receive absence alerts and reply to alerts through Hero.



### SIGN IN TO YOUR HERO ACCOUNT

1. Download the Hero by LINC-ED app from the app store to your smartphone or tablet, or alternatively on your computer enter: go.linc-ed.com

Your account will be set up by your school using the email address that you provided when you enrolled your children, use this address to request a password.

4. Check your email Hero will send you an email with a link to follow.
