

**David Street School  
Enrolment Scheme  
3 February 2014**

In order to avoid overcrowding, or the likelihood of overcrowding, the board of David Street School has adopted an enrolment scheme which has been approved by the Ministry of Education.

Under this scheme, students who wish to be enrolled at David Street School will be enrolled if they live within the home zone described below.

**Home Zone:**

Start at number 503 Thames Street and follow the Piako River north to Haumia Rd.

Follow Haumia Rd west (left) to Mangateparu Loop Rd. Turn left and head down Mangateparu Loop Rd to the intersection with Morrinsville-Tahuna Rd. Morrinsville-Tahuna Rd to number 743 odd and 746 even are included. Turn left and head south along Morrinsville-Tahuna Rd to Tauhei Rd then turn right and continue to number 177. Take a direct line from 177 Tauhei Rd to 432 Hangawera Rd. Take a direct line from 432 Hangawera Rd to the corner of Snell St and Avenue Rd. Hangawera Rd to number 432 and all of Grayden Rd are included. Head down Avenue Rd and turn left into Thames St. Head east along Thames St to Moorhouse St. Turn left and head north (up) Moorhouse St. Turn right into Foster Crescent then left onto David St and right onto Coronation Rd. Continue along Coronation Rd and turn right onto George St. Head down George St to North St and turn left. Turn right into Alexandra Avenue then left onto Thames St (303 odd and 388 even on Thames St are included). Head along Thames St to the river (503 and 504 Thames St.

Both sides of all streets and roads are included unless otherwise specified.

The enrolment of out of zone students is governed by the provisions of the Education Act 1989.

Proof of residence within the home zone may be required.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

## **Out of zone enrolments**

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary.

Second Priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.

Third Priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school.

Fourth Priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

Fifth Priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school, or a child of a member of the board of the school.

Sixth Priority must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group must be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
